Baboushka Performances - Tuesday 12th December

Venue: ALL SAINTS CHURCH

Length of show: 45 minutes

Collection: At the end of each performance a collection will be taken for the Church to thank the management committee for hosting our performances and rehearsals and to help cover the cost of heating the church for us.

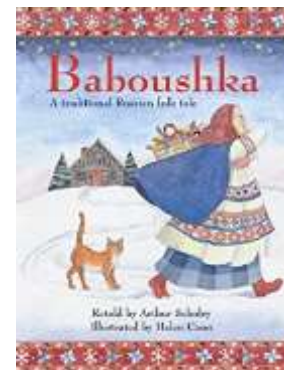
Children will need:

- Daps or trainers (shoes are very noisy on the stage)
- Warm trousers and a long-sleeved top to wear under their costume (the church isn't overly warm despite the heating)
- A coat and shoes to arrive in / wear home after the show

Children don't need:

- Water bottles - we take cups and there is water in the kitchen at the church

Toilet: There isn't a toilet in the church **so please make sure that your child goes to the toilet before they leave your house.** A local resident has kindly allowed the children to use her toilet during rehearsals. However, use of this toilet needs to be kept to a minimum i.e. emergencies only.



Afternoon Performance - Show starts at 2.00 pm. Church doors open 1.30 pm.

After dinner, the children will walk down to the church and change into their costumes which will be there from Monday's dress rehearsal. At the end of the performance, children

will change back into their school clothes and leave their costume in the church ready for the evening show. If you are attending the afternoon performance your child/ren can leave with you when the show is over - they do not need to come back to school. If you are not going to be present at the afternoon show, staff will walk your child/ren back to school so that you can collect them from school as per usual. Please understand that it may be closer to 3.15 pm by the time we get back to school.

If you have a relative/friend attending in the afternoon and wish your child to leave with them, you must tell your child's teacher or one of the TAs that this is to happen. We cannot let children go home with people other than parents, unless you have given permission for this to happen. Thank you.

Evening Performance - Show starts at 6.00 pm. Church doors open 5.30 pm.

Please bring your child back to the church for 5.30 pm. Try to arrive promptly but not before 5.30 pm as the church won't be open. Children will go straight into the side rooms at the church to put their costumes on. Parents/family members are welcome to wait in the pews.

At the end of the performance, children will leave with the adult/s who brought them. If someone else is collecting your child, please make sure to let a teacher or TA know. Thank you.

We look forward to seeing you all at what promise to be, really enjoyable performances.

Last Day Of Term 2 - Thursday 21st December

This is a mufti day when children are invited to come to school in comfortable clothing of their choice, perhaps with a Christmassy theme, although this is not essential.
