## Changes To Swimming Arrangements For 2018-2019

Swimming is part of the Key Stage 2 PE curriculum, and the expectation is that by the time children finish Year 6, they can swim 25 metres unaided.



In September 2018 the way we teach PE and sport, including swimming, at Nunney will change. Sports coaches will spend more time at the school, working in partnership with teachers to provide high quality sports teaching for all pupils across the week, rather than just on a Wednesday afternoon, offsite, at Tytherington. As part of this change to ensure that our children access a broad range of PE and sports teaching at different points in the week, swimming will no longer be provided for 30 weeks of the year for all children. Swimming costs a lot of money, not all parents have chosen to make the voluntary contribution this year, and it also takes considerable time out of the curriculum by the time changing and travel to and from the pool have been taken into account. Evaluation of children's swimming skills also shows that whilst Nunney pupils' confidence and enjoyment in the water is high, their actual swimming ability is no better than children who have swam for 8 consecutive weeks in Years 3 and 4 at Hayesdown First School.

So, for next year, only pupils in Otter Class will swim. 8 swimming sessions have been booked for them at Frome Sports Centre where the pool is larger and they can develop their swimming stamina. These lessons have been arranged for the Spring term 2019.

All children will access a minimum of 2 hours per week of PE and sports teaching, where their teachers will work in partnership with professional sports coaches to build pupils' fundamental movement skills and engage them in gymnastics, dance and a range of different sports across the year. There will also be increased opportunities for pupils to participate in interschool sports tournaments and perhaps a competition or two!

## National School Sports Week 25<sup>th</sup> - 29<sup>th</sup> June



**Monday 25<sup>th</sup> June** - today, pupils will experience the challenge and thrill of climbing a 4-sided rock wall. For Reception pupils and those with less confidence, there will be a wooden hut equipped with hand and foot holds for children to climb.



**Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> June** - children will work in mixed-age colour teams to complete a range of 'Crystal Maze' type challenges that will draw on their physical, problem-solving and teamwork skills. In the afternoon, pupils in Years 2 - 4 will try their hand at archery.

**Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> June** - across the morning there will be a range of sports tournaments and competitions for pupils to participate in on our school field. In the afternoon, children will go swimming as usual.

**Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> June** - will be a circus skills day for everyone. There will also be a circus skills show for pupils to enjoy.



## Sports Day - Friday 29<sup>th</sup> June **Please join us for this!**

A traditional Nunney Sports Day led by Mrs Andrews will take place on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> June. We do hope that you will be in attendance to cheer the children on, and enjoy the thrill and

challenge of the many races that will take place across the morning including the longstanding Nunney Mile for children in Years 3 and 4.

In preparation for the lead up to Sports Day, please ensure your child has their PE kit in school EVERY DAY. Thank you.

On Sports Day itself, children should come to school wearing a t-shirt that is the colour of their 'team'. This will be red, green or blue. Your child will probably know the colour of the team but please ask their teacher if they are not sure.

You are warmly invited to bring a picnic in to eat with the children at lunchtime. No hot lunches will be served on Sports Day but Fosse Way Kitchen will provide packed lunches for those children who have ordered them through Mrs Furlong. An order form for lunches on Sports Day and for the Festival of Words, accompanies this newsletter.

Children will come out of their classes to start the races at 9.10 am. After dropping children at school at 8.45 am, parents are asked to go straight across to the field where seating and hot drinks will be available.

After lunch you are welcome to take your child into their classroom to have a look at work in their books. As a special treat, once lunch has finished, you can take your child/ren home if you wish. Afternoon school will start at 1.00 pm for parents who don't want or are unable to take their child home at the end of lunchtime - the choice is yours!

### **Classes for 2018-2019**

We have 12 Reception pupils joining us in September, which is great news for Nunney School. For next school year, Reception and Year 1 pupils will be in Hedgehog Class and Miss Alison will be their teacher. Pupils in Years 2, 3 and 4 will be in Otter Class and will be taught by Miss Simmons and Mrs Baxter, who will provide additional teaching capacity in Otter Class where there will be children from 3 different year groups. Mrs Baxter will work all day on a Monday plus a Tuesday and Wednesday morning.
