Wednesday 28 th	Nasal spray flu vaccine given to children by the School Immunisation Team, where parents have given permission for this to happen - details below.

Flu Vaccine Available For All Children At Nunney School – Wednesday 28^{th} November



The children's flu vaccine is offered as a yearly nasal spray to young children to help protect them against flu. Flu can be a very unpleasant illness for children, with potentially serious complications, including bronchitis and pneumonia. In the autumn/winter of 2018/2019, the vaccine will be available free on the NHS for children in Reception and Years 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Nurses who work for the School Immunisation Team will administer the vaccine to your child in school if you have completed and returned the permission form to say that they can do this. The vaccine is given as a single spray squirted up each nostril. The nasal spray is quick, painless, and works even better than the injected flu vaccine.



Starting And Transferring School - September 2019



The admissions process for school place applications in September 2019 has begun and the website is live for parents and carers to make their on-line application. For children due to start school for the first time or transfer to a middle school the deadline date for applications is 15th January 2019.

In previous years, the Admissions and Entitlements Team has written to parents / carers of children due to start or transfer school explaining how to apply, key dates and where to find further information. Due to budgetary constraints, the team is no longer able to write individually to parents. Information can be found on the website www.somerset.gov.uk/admissions A booklet about how to apply for places is available on this website along with a link to the online application form you will need to complete.

Somerset's Admissions Team prefers online applications. However, you have the right to request a paper application form from Somerset Direct and can do this by phoning 0300 123 2224.

Even if you currently have a sibling at this school, or a sibling at a middle school, you MUST still make an application. Failure to do so may result in your child not getting a place at your preferred school.
